

Extended Terms of Use “Scompler AI Assistant” – Web Search Addendum – Version 1.0

Valid from July 14th, 2026

This Web Search Addendum (“Addendum”) supplements the Extended Terms of Use “Scompler AI Assistant” (“Extended Terms”) and the respective underlying General Terms and Conditions (available at <https://scompler.com/agb>), as well as any existing agreements for the use of Scompler. Activation of the optional “Scompler AI Web Search” requires prior consent to this Web Search Addendum for a project; without such consent, the “Scompler AI Web Search” will not be activated. The Extended Terms continue to apply unchanged.

For the purposes of this Addendum, “Customer” (also “you”) means the contractual partner of Scompler Technologies GmbH under the underlying General Terms and Conditions or the agreement for the use of Scompler. “Consenting person” means the natural person who, on behalf of and with effect for the Customer, consents to this Addendum and activates Scompler AI Web Search (typically a project administrator). That person must be authorised to represent the Customer; the Customer ensures this is the case. Terms not otherwise defined in this Addendum have the meaning given in the Extended Terms.

Where this Addendum conflicts with the Extended Terms, this Addendum prevails for the Web Search feature only. All other provisions of the Extended Terms remain in full force.

1. What Web Search does. When activated, Web Search allows the Scompler AI Assistant to retrieve up-to-date information from the public internet. To do so, Scompler transmits a search query, derived from the user’s request, to the external search provider selected for the project. Only the search query is transmitted to the provider. Your full prompt, project content, strategy data, conversation history and uploaded documents are not sent to the search provider.

2. Selected provider as an additional sub-processor. By activating Web Search and selecting a provider for your project, the consenting person, acting on behalf of and with effect for the Customer, authorises that provider to act as an additional sub-processor of Scompler Technologies GmbH for the processing of search queries, in addition to the sub-processor(s) named in the Extended Terms. The available providers are:

- (a) Linkup – Linkup Technologies SAS, France (EU). Search queries are processed within the European Union. Selecting Linkup does not alter the EU data-residency position described in the Extended Terms.
- (b) Brave Search – Brave Software Inc., United States (US). Search queries are processed in the United States. By selecting Brave Search you acknowledge and accept that, for this feature, query data is transferred outside the European Union, and that the EU-only data-residency description in the Extended Terms does not apply to queries sent to Brave Search. Brave Search takes the position that API search-query data is not personal data; you remain responsible for the lawfulness of the queries you send.

3. No personal data in queries. As with all input to the Scompler AI Assistant, you must ensure you have a valid legal basis for any personal data you process, and we recommend avoiding the inclusion of personal data in prompts and therefore in search queries. You remain responsible for the lawfulness of the data transmitted to the selected provider.

4. Provider terms. Each provider processes data under its own terms and data processing agreement. Further information, including each provider's data processing agreement, Standard Contractual Clauses (where applicable) and sub-processor list, can be found in the following provider resources:

5. Changing or disabling the feature. A project administrator may change the selected provider or disable Web Search at any time in the project settings. Disabling Web Search ends the transmission of new queries to the provider. Switching providers requires acceptance of this Web Search Addendum in respect of the newly selected provider.

6. Billing. The use and billing of Web Search is based on the Scompler AI credit model, in the same way as other Scompler AI Assistant usage, as described in the Extended Terms.

7. Relationship to the Extended Terms. Except as expressly modified for the Web Search feature by this Addendum, all terms, warranties, limitations of liability, data-protection provisions and other conditions of the Extended Terms apply to your use of Web Search.
