To activate the "Scompler AI Assistant," the following terms and conditions must be accepted; without consent, the "Scompler AI Assistant" will not be activated:

These extended terms of use ("Extended Terms of Use") govern the use of artificial intelligence in Scompler.

No further legal rights to "Scompler AI Assistant" can be derived from the right of use granted. You acknowledge that all right, title and interest in and to "Scompler AI Assistant", including any existing patents, copyrights, trademarks, trade secrets and other intellectual property rights, shall remain the property of Scompler Technologies GmbH or its licensors, without limitation to the aforementioned legal positions.

As between you and Scompler Technologies GmbH, you retain all right, title, and interest in and to the content you generate using the 'Scompler AI Assistant' (the 'Output') (i.e., all generated content, media, code, or data). You may not claim or grant any right, title or interest in or to this technology or its associated intellectual property and shall comply with all applicable intellectual property laws and regulations.

For the sole purpose of enabling the provision, display, storage, and optimization of the 'Scompler AI Assistant' service, you grant Scompler Technologies GmbH and its third-party service providers a worldwide, non-exclusive, royalty-free, transferable, and sublicensable license to host, use, reproduce, modify, and display the Output during the term of your use.
